

National President, Michael G. Polo

While also in D.C., I was able to witness the major effort to refurbish our headquarters. The National Office has gone under a significant “spring cleaning,” and an aesthetic upgrade is in the works thanks to the Sons of Italy Foundation which owns the building. We were also able to add two new employees to our National Office staff: Dalia

Schulman is our new Program Coordinator, and Jane Ellis is our new Bookkeeper. Welcome to OSDIA!

A highlight of March was certainly the Supreme Council plenary session on March 1st and 2nd. This session was virtual, and I attended from the National Headquarters in D.C. along with more than a dozen others who, like me, feel such events are better in person. Going forward, I am committed to making sure that all plenary sessions, starting with the next session scheduled for St. Louis this August 8-10, will be entirely in person. The session in March was productive and inspired a Special Supreme Convention session for April 6th to finalize some of the initiatives born from the latest plenary.

March also welcomed the release of the film *Cabrini* in theaters. Many, like myself, who were granted access to not only the film but its producers, cast, and crew, were particularly excited about this magnificent film being shared with the public. Every single aspect of *Cabrini* speaks to not only the extraordinary accomplishments of Mother Cabrini but also to the struggles, perseverance, and contributions of Italians in America. Such films advance our mission to fight defamation and champion our heritage. The overriding themes of compassion, community, and service are particularly important as we move forward with our mission.

Another aspect of our mission, outreach, and collaboration, was advanced through a trip I took to Canada to attend the annual gala of the Order Sons and Daughters of Italy in Canada (OSDIC). The gala was attended by 1,400 people and was a highly successful event that raised \$750,000 for a local hospital. It is my intention to reestablish close relations with our Brothers & Sisters in Canada, and much of my time there was dedicated to this goal. I'm happy to report that the leadership of OSDIC shares this objective, and I look forward to returning to Canada in May for the swearing-in of their new officers.

I also traveled in March to Seattle to celebrate the 80th year of membership of Lucy Colarossi Salle, a member of the Grand Lodge of the Northwest. This was truly an honor, and it's incredibly important that we recognize such individuals on occasions that represent their commitment to our beloved Order. Congratulations, Lucy!

After Seattle, I flew to New York to attend the Grand Lodge of New York's *41st Anniversary Celebration* of the Commission for Social Justice (CSJ). The brunch event honored New York OSDIA State Immediate Past President, Tony Narcaratto, and Dr. Joseph V. Scelsa, Founder and President of the Italian American Museum. Also recognized was State Past President Michele Cangiano Ment for her significant support of the CSJ. Occasions such as this allow for our CSJ to continue the essential work of fighting defamation, promoting a positive image of Italian Americans, and preserving the legacy of Christopher Columbus who is a symbol of the incredible contributions those of Italian descent have made to America.

Celebrating Tradition: Feast of St. Joseph at Garibaldi Meucci Museum

On March 19, 2024, the Garibaldi Meucci Museum in Staten Island, NY, came alive with the vibrant festivities of "La Tavola di San Giuseppe," the Feast of St. Joseph. The event honored an age-old Italian tradition brought to America by early immigrants. Originating in Southern Italy, this celebration pays homage to St. Joseph amidst a spread of symbolic foods.

These offerings, including breads shaped to represent St. Joseph and Jesus, artichokes, oranges, lemons, fava beans, and delightful zeppole, hold deep cultural significance. The altar adorned with candles, flowers, and a statue of St. Joseph welcomed Father Carlos Limongi of St. Joseph's Church, who blessed the table. The event, held in the historic 1843 Meucci home, owned and administered since 1919 by the Order Sons and Daughters of Italy in America and thru the Sons of Italy Foundation (SIF) drew a gathering of 65 guests. Fran Cicero, AnnMarie Cicero, Carol Berardi, and Joseph Sciamè were acknowledged for their contributions to the event's success.
