

National President, Michael G. Polo



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As we enter the month of October, I would like to wish you all a happy Italian American Heritage Month. I would also like to thank everyone in the OSDIA family for the birthday wishes last week. September was a busy, yet exciting, month, as many lodges held Festas and prepared for Italian American Heritage Month celebrations. I had the opportunity to attend a local Festa hosted by the John Pirelli Lodge #1633 in Dayton, Ohio on



September 6th, which was a wonderful celebration of Italian food and culture.

October began for me in Boston, Massachusetts, where I attended the Italian American Heritage Month celebration at the State House on October 1st, marking the 25th anniversary of Italian Heritage Month in Massachusetts. On October 6th, I will be joined by Commission for Social Justice (CSJ) President Robert Ferrito in New Orleans, for the unveiling of a CSJ-sponsored memorial plaque, honoring the 11 Italian immigrants who were lynched there in 1891.

I will then be visiting New York City on October 7th to attend A Chance In Life's 79th Annual Gala, during which Sons of Italy Foundation (SIF) President Joseph Sciame will be named among four other distinguished honorees. I also have the privilege of attending other events held by esteemed organizations like the Columbus Citizens Foundation and the Italian Welfare League.

I am also excited to announce that OSDIA will be leading the Columbus Day Parade in New York City on October 14th, a day which will begin with a breakfast hosted by the Italian American Museum, the Lt. Det. Joseph Petrosino Association in America and the NYS Grand Lodge Foundation. Upon leaving New York, I will be closing out the month in Washington, D.C. at the National Italian American Foundation's 49th Anniversary Gala on October 26th.

I am honored to be able to attend so many important Italian American Heritage Month and Columbus Day celebrations, and I hope to see many of you there.

Celebrating Italian Heritage: 47th Annual Italian Fall Festival at John Pirelli Lodge

From September 6-8, 2024, OSDIA National President Michael G. Polo and National Executive Director Shayla Kaestle attended the 47th Annual Italian Fall Festival hosted by the John Pirelli Lodge in Dayton, OH, which has more than 500 members. They were warmly welcomed by National Trustee and Festival Chair Brian Andzik, Local Lodge President Jack Giambrone, Grand Lodge of OH President Dave Corsi, National Orator Tony Perfilio, and hundreds of members and volunteers.

During the event, they explored the lodge's expansive 10-acre property, enjoyed authentic Italian

cuisine, including cannoli and cookies, tasted flights of Italian wine, and participated in bocce games on one of the lodge's six courts. The festivities also included live music, featuring the crowd favorite, Aaron Caruso, and interactive games showcasing the diverse regions of Italy.

The annual Fall Festa raises funds for various local, state, and national charities, and this year's event was the lodge's largest fundraiser yet. We congratulate the John Pirelli Lodge on a record-breaking year and look forward to many more successful festivals in the future!



Annapolis Lodge #2225 Hosts Annual Festa Italiana, Raising \$25,000 for Charity

On Sunday, September 15, Lodge #2225 in Annapolis, Maryland, held its annual Festa Italiana, bringing the local community together to celebrate Italian American culture while raising funds for charity. The event featured a wide array of Italian food and beverages, with local vendors offering assorted Italian goods. Live music entertained attendees throughout the day, and lodge members sold traditional Italian desserts like cannoli, pizzelle, and sfogliatelle inside the lodge.

"This is a chance for people in the community to connect with their Italian roots," said Lodge President Ray Gamble. He emphasized the importance of providing the local community with an authentic Italian cultural experience, calling the Festa a "slice of Italian culture."

The event annually raises approximately \$25,000 for charities such as the Alzheimer's Association, the Cooley's Anemia Foundation, and Help Our Military Heroes. Ray also noted that part of the funds support the lodge's scholarship program, with different activities during the day dedicated to various charitable causes.

Feast of Saint Francis

Festa di San Francesco d'Assisi Patrono d'Italia

Saint Francis of Assisi, born in Umbria in 1118, is the patron saint of animals and nature. Known for his devotion to "Lady Poverty," he renounced wealth to live like Christ, following Matthew 10:7, 9-11: "*Provide neither gold nor silver...for the workman is worthy of his meat.*" Saint Francis left a lasting impact on Christianity, building schools, hospitals, and restoring San Damiano. He is also credited with creating the live nativity scene, a tradition that continues worldwide.

His Feast Day, celebrated on October 4, marks his transition to heaven and is a day of reflection. In Italy, Assisi honors him with religious services and oil-lit ceremonies at the Basilica of St. Francis. Some regions bless pets in honor of his love for animals.

In lodges, celebrations could include volunteering, cooking mostaccioli (a favorite of St. Francis),

making Tau crosses, or hosting candlelight ceremonies. Outdoor activities like hikes or learning St. Francis's prayers offer meaningful ways to connect with his legacy.


